

A TRIP TO DEER ISLAND

Drive to St. George in southern New Brunswick, then take NB-172 south for about 16 km to Letete.

DEER ISLAND FERRY

In good weather, exit your vehicle and enjoy the sun and the sea.

The Deer Island ferry runs between Letete and Deer Island every half hour.
The ride is free and takes 20 minutes.



ENGLISH BAR BEACH (Lambert's Cove)

About ½ way along the beach, you can sit on the beams of the seawall and look west across Passamaquoddy Bay to St. Andrews. Great sunsets here!

From the Deer Island Ferry warf, drive about 1.1 km on NB-172 to an intersection.
Turn right onto Lambert Rd., drive for 1.4 km to an intersection and park near the beach.



DEVIL'S HAND

This glacial rock formation looks like huge fingers on a rock face.

From Lambert'sd Cove, turn left onto Hersonville Rd. and go 1.8 km to an intersection.

Go straight through the intersection onto the Northern Harbour Rd.

Drive 1.2 km to an atv trail on the left and park opposite it.

Devil's Hand is located right at the road side, on the cliff face beside the atv trail.



LEONARDVILLE LIGHTHOUSE

The view from the 20 meter cliff top is nice, but beware of the edge.

The lighthouse is not very noticeable from the road, so it's easy to miss.

Reverse direction on the Northern Harbour Rd. and return for 1.8 km to an intersection.

Turn right onto Cooks Lane and drive 1.7 km to an intersection.


Turn right onto route 772 and continue for 3.6 km to a T-junction.

Turn left and drive 2.1 km to the Leonardville wharf, and then continue on for another **400 meters** until you are about even with the end of a guardrail on the left side of the road.

Pull off as far as possible; carefully cross the road and walk the short but steep trail to the lighthouse.

From the cliff top, there is a good view of the East Quoddy Lighthouse 4.5 km away on Campobello Island.

***you can also park in a wide area on the left, just past the wharf and walk up to the lighthouse trail.**



CLARK GREGORY NATURE PRESERVE

A short 1.5 km trail with a couple of look-offs.


The best look-off is the upper one near the end of the trail.

Continue on route 772 for 2.2 km to civic address 1500 + 1502 on a pole on the left hand side.

Turn left onto a gravel road and drive 50 meters to a parking area on the right.

Park, then walk 200 meters down the road to a side trail on the left.

The trail first goes to a small building, then follows the ridge past 2 look-offs, and ultimately reaches the paved road .



DEER ISLAND POINT

A great spot for a picnic and walk on a small beach.

If the tide is right, you can see the Old Sow whirl pool.

Return to route 772, turn left and drive about 2.5 km to an intersection.

Turn left onto the Deer Island Point Rd.

Drive 1.8 km to a road on the right, with the old Canada Customs Office on the left side of the road.

***Continuing straight takes you to the seasonal Campobello Island Ferry landing.**

Turn right onto a road that takes you up through a campground to Deer Island Point.



Return to the Deer Island Ferry Landing

From Deer Island point, return 1.8 km to the intersection with route 772.

Turn left and follow the road through Fairhaven and ultimately back to the Ferry Landing.

GREEN'S POINT LIGHTHOUSE (not on Deer Island)

The lighthouse is one of the nicest places around to watch the sunset.

You can see 4 lighthouses from here.

Once you are back on the mainland at Letete, drive about 350 meters and turn right onto the Greens Point Road, then drive about 1.5 km to a beach and a lighthouse.

The road crosses a gravel bar to the lighthouse.

BEACH ACCESS: Park on the left BEFORE the road crosses the bar.

LIGHTHOUSE: Drive across the bar and a few meters up towards the lighthouse and park in the visitors parking area on the left.
