

AVENGER CRASH SITE, LONG FALLS, BALANCING ROCK, CHIMNEY ROCK

GETTING THERE:

From Fredericton, take Route 105 west to Mouth of Keswick, then turn right onto route 104. Drive 40.5 km on route 104, through Burtts Corner, Zealand and Millville to Hawkins Corner. Turn right at Hawkins Corner and drive 14.2 km to Becaguimec South Branch Road on the right. Turn right and drive 5.1 km to a road on the left. Turn left and drive 4.7 km to an intersection.

AVENGER CRASH SITE (46° 18.296'N 67° 14.893'W)

At the intersection, continue straight for about 150 meters to a sharp left turn. Turn left and drive about 530 meters to a side road on the right. Look for signage directing you to the nearby crash site and a memorial sign.

***this is the site where an Avenger airplane crashed in 1958.**



LONG FALLS (46° 19.655'N 67° 14.660'W)

Return to the last intersection mentioned in GETTING THERE

Turn left at the intersection and drive 2 km to a road on the left.

Drive 3.4 km on this road until you come to the trail on the left at

Position (46° 19.661'N 67° 14.551'W)

Get out and take the muddy trail down to the waterfall. (150 meters)

A cottage sits along the brook.

The waterfall has two sections with a sluice between the two.

The waterfall makes its way through a small crack in the rock.



BALANCING ROCK

Backtrack 3.3 km to the previous road and turn left.

Drive 5 km east to an intersection.

Turn left and drive 100 meters to Road D20.

Turn left and drive 100 meters to a road on the right with a Balancing Rock sign.

Drive 720 meters and park near where a side road turns left with a B. Rock sign.

Go 350 meters up the side road to a small shelter called the Prosser Rest Area.

The short trail to Balancing Rock begins to the right of the shelter.

Balancing rock is a large block of granite left by the last ice age.



CHIMNEY ROCK

Return to Road D20, turn right and drive another 8 km north to a side road on the left (between markers 21 + 20) with a sign marked "Chimney Rock"

*there is an orange pipe marked #29, across from this side road.

***near the orange pipe, you can walk down a trail on the right for 270 meters to the Nashwaak River.**



To go to Chimney Rock:

Turn left onto the side road, and drive 2.2 km to a rough road on the right, with a “Chimney Rock” sign.


Park and walk 750 meters up this road to a bench and a sign saying Chimney Rock.

The ravine is on your right at this point

The ravine is deep and steep sided, with broken rock at the bottom.

You can make your way down a metal ladder, and go carefully over broken rock to the far end of the ravine to see the chimney rock formation.
