

BLACK HOLE TRAIL (Fundy National Park)

Distance: 10.86 km, 4 hours return (linear trail)

Difficulty: Moderate

GETTING THERE:

From the bridge in Alma, continue 3.4 km east on route 114 and turn left onto the 45 Road.

Drive 2.24 km and take the left fork.

Drive 1.77 km to a small field/parking area on the left. (45° 39.383'N 64° 56.038'W)

THE TRAIL:

The Black Hole Trail is a wide graveled path passing through mixed forest and stands of sugar maple.

This 5.5 km trail leads to the Upper Salmon River and the 'Black Hole' pool. (45° 37.635'N 64° 58.508'W)

The deep pool is a favorite place to swim on a hot summer day, and in the fall, is a resting place for Atlantic salmon on their way upriver to spawn.
