

CORBETT BROOK TRAIL

Distance: 1.5 km

Difficulty: Easy

This short trail leads first to a small waterfall on Corbett Brook, then along the brook to a region of broken sandstone cliffs, shallow caves and overhanging rocks.

Caution:

Use caution when parking along Kimble Drive.

Be careful if climbing around the cliffs and caves.

Getting There:

In Fredericton, drive along Kimble Drive to the ScotiaBank South Field. (Near the Grant Harvey Center)

Park along Kimble Drive, across from the Football field.

Walk into the gravel area that is blocked with a chain.

The Trail:

When the short trail intersects another trail, turn left and walk down the hill across a culvert containing Corbett Brook.

At around 330 meters turn left onto a side trail.

There are some alternate trails in this area, but it is best to walk down to the falls, and then follow the trail along the brook.

You will pass areas of cliffs, large cracks in the rock and some shallow caves and overhangs.

Follow the trail for 300 meters along the brook, and then take a trail on the right for 250 meters back to the main trail.

Turn right onto the main trail and follow it for 850 meters back to your vehicle.
