

Cub Camp Falls

***also includes Bulls Creek Falls, Essepenack Falls**

Drive to Nackawic and cross the Hawkshaw Bridge over the Saint John River to the northern side.

Bulls Creek Falls: 45° 57.857'N 67° 19.442'W

Turn left onto NB-105 and drive about 6 km to the Bulls Creek Falls visible from the highway to your right.



Essepenack Falls: 46° 3.423'N 67° 33.044'W *200 meters round trip

Continue for about another 21.6 km and watch for the Jolly Farmer sign on your right, then drive about 200 meters and park just past the bridge, in an opening between 2 sets of guardrails. Cross the road and descend the steep bank to the flat land along Gibson Creek and walk a short ways to the falls.

***Essepenack was the Maliseet word for “Steep Sided”, and was their name for Gibson Creek.**



Cub Camp Falls: 46° 3.775'N 67° 31.904'W *3 km round trip

Return to your vehicle and walk up the road about 150 meters and turn right onto an old road. Walk up this road for about 300 meters and turn right into a clearing. Walk past a large tree encircled with pink tape, then follow the trail a short ways onto a ridge. From here basically follow the high ridge along Gibson Creek, keeping to high ground until near the falls. At about location, 46° 3.765'N 67° 32.042'W begin the steep descent on a heading of 80 degrees to the falls. *there are no trail markings. *this route takes you along a beautiful hemlock ridge, but the falls may also be accessed from the Crabbe Forestry Gate on the other side of Gibson Creek, or by walking up the creek when the water is lower and warmer.
