

DALLING'S CAVE

Distance: 2.5 km return

Duration: 2.5 hours

The cliff near the cave entrance is unstable.

The water echoing through the cave makes a neat and ominous sound, but stay out of the cave unless you really know what you are doing.

The brook makes a rough and rocky trail, and it is easier to keep to the high ground on the left side of the brook.

Getting There:

From the Tim Horton's at 638 Main Street in Sussex, turn left and drive about 3 km on Main Street to the Sussex Corner area.

Bear left at a Y-junction onto the Waterford Road, and drive 9.9 km to Waterford.

Pass the Cedar Camp Road on the left and continue for 1.8 km to a Y-junction.

Park in the open area between the two roads, just before a bridge. (45° 40.179'N 65° 21.130'W)

The Trail:

Walk across the bridge and locate the remains of an old road on the left.

Walk NW along the old road for about 250 meters, to where it turns sharply right.

Do not turn right at this corner, but continue straight NW a short ways downhill to a brook.

Follow the brook upstream for about 100 meters, then cross to the other side and ascend the ridge. (45° 40.303'N 65° 21.114'W)

Walk NE, keeping to the edge of the high ground for nearly a kilometer until near the cave. (45° 40.489'N 65° 20.693'W)

Descend to the brook and walk upstream for about 50 meters to where the brook exits the cave. (45° 40.504'N 65° 20.684'W)
