

Eagle Rock Trail

This is a short, challenging and scenic trail.

Distance: 1.5 km for main trail + 500 meters for the loop trail at the top.

Difficulty: Difficult due to the steepness of the trail. The trail sometime skirts high cliffs, so be careful if hiking with children or pets.



Recommendations: I think this trail is best hiked in a counter clockwise direction. There are a couple of very nice lookouts at the top, but stay back from the edge.

Getting There:

From the Irving store in Welsford, drive SE for about 4.3 km and park at the Eagle Rock Picnic area.

The Trail:

Walk back NE along the highway for 400 meters to where the trail begins on the left.

*there is red flagging tape and a cairn of stones marking the trail.

Follow the trail to the top and a nice lookout with a bench.

From the bench area, another trail loops around the top of the mountain, but it is not that nice, with no views and some very steep going in places.

From the bench, continue along the top of the ridge and then descend to the picnic area and your vehicle.
