

## FREDERICTON JUNCTION AREA HIKES

**Caution: Some of the gravel roads mentioned here may not be passable at times, so be cautious.**

**White Rapids Park Trail (45° 39.589'N 66° 36.669'W ) & Picnic area**

**Explore the interesting wooden statues scattered along the park trails.**

**Halfway around the trail, there is an excellent place to sit and overlook the river.**

**The picnic area commemorates a time over 100 years ago when circus elephants bathed in the river here.**

**When the water is very low, the exposed ledges are a neat spot to wander about.**

Travel route 101 to Fredericton Junction and turn west onto the Mill Pond Road. (200 meters south of the Sunbury West School)

The picnic area is located 150 meters in the road on the right.

The trail head for White Rapids Park is located another 350 meters along this road.



**The Peddler's Monument (45° 38.533'N 66° 37.621'W) & Gravesite**

**The Diamond Square road was once part of the stagecoach route between Saint Andrews and Fredericton.**

From White Rapids Park, return about 200 meters, turn right and drive under a railway overpass to an intersection.

Turn left, drive 180 meters and turn right onto the Diamond Square Road.

Drive about 2.4 km the Diamond Square road to the Peddlers monument on the left.

Stop and check out the statue and display.

Continue on the road for about 1 km to a side road on the right.

Park and walk up this trail 280 meters to a wide spot.

Turn left and walk down a short woods trail to the Peddlers grave.



**Scribner Falls** (45° 37.192'N 66° 36.467'W)

**Not a large falls, but a very short walk.**

Return to the start of the Diamond Square Road and turn right onto the Gore Road.

Drive about 4 km along the Gore Road until it joins NB-785 (paved)

Turn right and drive south for 1.1 km to the Scribner Falls trailhead on the right.



**There are 3 other sites in this area, shown on the area map, but since I have not gone to them yet, I can't vouch for the road conditions:**


Hemlock Grove

Simpson Falls


