

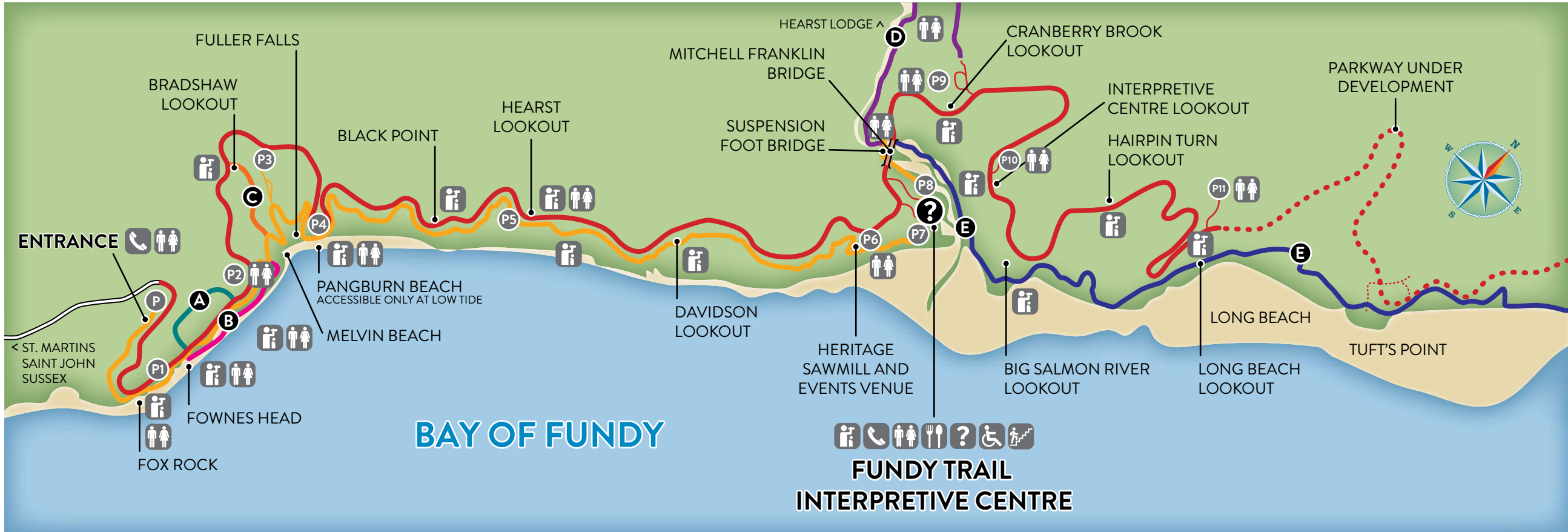


# MAP AND GUIDE TO THE FUNDY TRAIL

# WELCOME TO THE FUNDY TRAIL

## DID YOU KNOW...

- The Fundy Trail is a 2,559 hectare linear park and ecosystem.
- The paved roadway is 16 kms (12 mi.) and passes through 251 million year old rock. Construction is under development to reach the boundaries of Fundy National Park. Completion date is slated for 2018.
- The 10 km (6 mi.) coastal multi-use trail parallels to the roadway for walking, hiking and biking.
- 23 lookouts providing unique and spectacular views (many are wheelchair friendly).
- Visit the Interpretive Centre and nearby Heritage Sawmill to learn about the history of the area.
- Gift Shop and light snacks available at the Interpretive Centre.
- Traverse the 84-metre (275-foot) suspension bridge across Big Salmon River.
- Climb down a cable ladder to the base of Fuller Falls.
- Ask about our Guided Walks and Hearst Lodge Day Adventures.
- A free family one-hour guided tour every Sunday at 1pm.
- Children's Fundy Discovery Hunt - available at the entrance kiosk and at the Interpretive Centre.
- Participate in our daily scheduled "moose calling" at the Interpretive Centre.
- Explore three beaches – Melvin Beach, Pangburn Beach (accessible at low tide) and Big Salmon River Beach.
- Experience breathtaking views along the Fundy Trail coastline from a kayak.
- The Fundy Trail is part of the UNESCO world biosphere and Stonehammer Geopark, one of the two geoparks in North America.
- The Fundy Footpath, a world famous challenging wilderness trail that hugs the coastline 41 kms (24 mi.) to the boundaries of Fundy National Park, begins at the suspension bridge.

## LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY

**EASY** – For those who feel comfortable walking 2 to 4 hours a day on mainly level terrain. Leisurely paced with ample time to enjoy the culture and countryside.

**MODERATE** – TRAILS **A** and **B**  
For those who feel comfortable walking 2 to 5 hours a day. Walking trails can include smooth and/or uneven footpaths and some ascents up to 400 feet.

**CHALLENGING**  
TRAILS **C** **D** and **E**  
For more experienced hikers who feel comfortable walking 3 to 6 hours a day. Trails have an uneven terrain with some steeper ascents from 1,000 to 2,400 feet. You need to be in good condition to fully enjoy the challenges of this classification.

## HEARST LODGE DAY ADVENTURE

A four-hour guided interpretive hike from the Big Salmon River Suspension Bridge to the Hearst Lodge. You will hike through old-growth forest and learn about the flora, fauna and history of the lodge. Enjoy a picnic lunch overlooking the pristine salmon pool. The lodge was once owned by US Newspaper magnate J. Randolph Hearst. It is a moderately challenging hike and appropriate footwear is recommended.

**Cost is \$40 per adult and \$20 for youth ages 7-12.**  
**Reservations must be made 24 hours in advance.**
