

HEMLOCK RIDGE WALK (Killarney Lake)

Difficulty: Moderate

Distance: 5 km return

There are many interconnected and confusing trails in this park, so it's a good idea to bring a map + compass if unfamiliar with the area.

This hike includes a 1.5 kilometer walk along a high ridge behind Killarney Lake, forested with large Hemlocks.

The route along the ridge is flagged with orange tape, and includes portions of old wood roads and an atv trail.

DIRECTIONS:

Park near the Rotary Lodge.

Walk into the open area to the RIGHT of the lodge, and follow the E-ROUTE for 1.25 km until you arrive at the BLUE trail.

Turn LEFT onto the BLUE Trail, and walk 250 meters to some orange flagging tape on the LEFT.

Follow the tape along the ridge for 1.5 km until you come to a wood road.

Turn RIGHT onto this road and follow it for 320 meters to the ORANGE trail.

Follow the ORANGE trail for 500 meters and take a sharp RIGHT.

Continue on the ORANGE trail for 420 meters and take a sharp LEFT.

Continue on the ORANGE trail for 450 meters to the BLUE trail.

Turn RIGHT onto the BLUE trail and go 350 meters to a junction.

Follow the E-ROUTE for 1.25 km back to the lodge.
