

SHELDON POINT TRAIL (45° 13.542'N 66° 7.067'W)

Distance: 5 km loop

Difficulty: Moderate

Comments: This is a very nice trail encompassing both beach and forest.

Caution: The last 1.5 km of this loop involves walking along the fairly busy Sand Cove Rd.

Getting There:

From the Lancaster Mall in west Saint John, take Catherwood St. south onto Bleury St., then turn right onto Sand Cove Rd.

Drive about 3.1 km on Sand Cove Rd until you reach the beach.

Park at the near end of the beach adjacent to the large Sheldon Point Trail sign.

The Trail:

Turn left and walk along the beach for about 800 meters and then cut sharply up the hill.

From here walk roughly east through an old sand pit for about 1 km until you see some bathrooms and a log fence at Sheldons Point.

From here, the trail goes northwest for about 1.5 km to a large grey barn and picnic tables.

Turn left and walk down Sand Cove Rd. for 1.5 km to your vehicle.
