

ST. PADDY'S FALLS (Bocabec, NB)

Distance: about 350 meters

Difficulty: Easy

A nice walk through the woods to a neat waterfall.

Getting There:

Between St. George and St. Stephen on Highway 1, take exit 39.

*If coming from the St. George, take exit 39, turn right and drive 100 meters, then turn left onto the Basin Access Road.

*If coming from the St. Stephen, take exit 39, turn left and drive 550 meters, then turn left onto the Basin access Road.

Drive 2.7 km along the Basin Access Road until the Kerrs Ridge Road intersects on the left, just north of an overpass.

Continue right, on the Kerrs Ridge Road for about another 100 meters and park on the right near a speed limit sign.

The Trail:

Carefully cross the road, climb over a guard rail and locate the trail at a sign on a utility pole.

Follow the flagged trail for about 10 minutes to the falls.
